

Essential Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ Ensure their daughter attends school every day✓ Drop off and collect their daughter on time✓ Plan family holidays within the school breaks✓ Contact the school as soon as possible about any absences✓ Ensure their daughter has adequate sleep and has a healthy breakfast✓ Provide their daughter with the correct uniform and school
Attitude, Behaviour and Effort	<ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ Encourage their daughter to follow the school rules and values✓ Promote positive behaviour and support the school with regard to rules and behaviour policies✓ Encourage their daughter to respect all adults and students✓ Encourage their daughter to be organised and independent✓ Support the school in promoting the culture and traditions of the UAE and respecting other cultures✓ Ensure their daughter remembers to wear a seat belt
Learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ Show an interest in their daughter's learning✓ Encourage their daughter to do her best at all times✓ Encourage their daughter to follow the homework guidance and complete homework on time✓ Provide a quiet area and, where possible, a computer to complete homework✓ Check homework and sign the homework diary daily✓ Support the school's ICT e-safety policy and ensure safe ICT use at home
Communication and Support	<ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ Keep in regular contact with the school and follow advice regarding academic and social matters✓ Request an appointment to discuss any matter of concern that may be affecting their daughter at school✓ Attend parent meetings and other events✓ Read and respond to phone calls, school letters, SMS and other communication✓ Provide feedback to assist in school improvement
Opportunities and Achievements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ Encourage their daughter to make full use of all the opportunities offered at school✓ Attend school events to celebrate their daughter's achievements

Essential Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ Promote the highest possible levels of attendance✓ Monitor attendance and punctuality and inform parents of any issues✓ Check uniform and equipment are correct and inform students and parents if we have any concerns
Attitude, Behaviour and Effort	<ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ Teach and encourage students to follow the school rules and values✓ Encourage respect, consideration and support for others✓ Encourage students to be organised and independent✓ Ensure safety and do not tolerate bullying✓ Follow the school behaviour and rewards system in a fair and consistent way✓ Encourage students to reach their full potential✓ Promote the culture and traditions of the UAE and encourage respect for other cultures✓ Ensure students wear seatbelts on school transport and encourage their use at other times
Learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ Plan, prepare and teach effective and creative lessons that develop skills for life✓ Plan differentiated activities that motivate and challenge all students✓ Set, mark and monitor homework following school policies✓ Provide constructive and timely feedback for students✓ Use learning targets to support student learning and motivation✓ Educate and promote the safe use of ICT and the Internet by following school policies
Communication and Support	<ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ Encourage pupils to share concerns and take appropriate action✓ Offer students guidance and support✓ Inform parents/carers about achievements or concerns✓ Communicate professionally and regularly through diaries, reports, phone calls, SMS and newsletters✓ Deal with parent concerns and communications promptly and effectively
